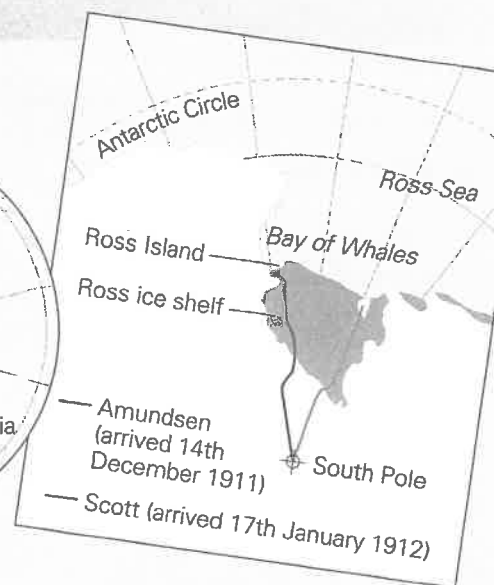
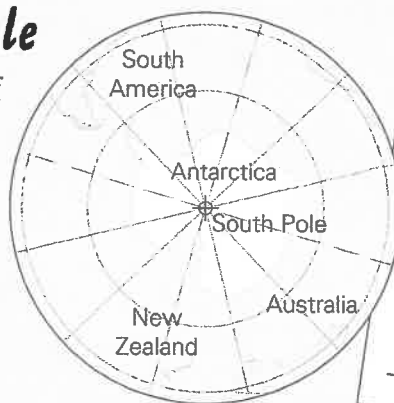

The race to the South Pole

- The South Pole is on the continent of Antarctica. Antarctica is the coldest and driest continent on Earth, with a minimum temperature of -80°C in winter. Ice caps cover 98% of the continent, which is also home to 70% of the world's freshwater. There are no permanent residents, only around 1,000 people working at the research stations there.
- In 1910, British Captain Robert Scott and Norwegian explorer Roald Amundsen planned expeditions to reach the South Pole. Captain Robert Scott wanted to study emperor penguins and place the British flag at the South Pole. Amundsen said that he wanted to study the Southern Sea, but he really wanted to be the first to reach the South Pole.
- Scott departed on his ship, the *Terra Nova*, from Cardiff, Wales, with three motor sledges, 19 ponies, 33 dogs and 24 men in June 1910. Amundsen left Oslo on the ship *Fram* in August 1910 with nearly 100 sledge dogs, sledges and 19 men.
- In January 1911, Amundsen reached Antarctica and set up a base camp. The Norwegian team built a small wooden hut and they spent the first months there organizing depots of food and equipment southward and making preparations for the long journey to the South Pole.
- Amundsen's final journey began in October 1911 with five men on sledges pulled by dogs. They finally reached the South Pole on 14th December 1911. They set up a camp and stayed there for three days checking that



they really were at the South Pole. Then they planted the Norwegian flag there and started the journey back to their base camp as winner of the race.

- Scott's team also arrived in Antarctica in January 1911 and set up their base camp. Scott planned to organize different depots using his motor sledges, but they broke down. The team started the race to the South Pole in November 1911 using the ponies to transport food and equipment, but the ponies started sinking into the soft snow and some died.
- Scott chose four members of his team to go with him on the final stage of the journey to the South Pole. The five men were pulling the sledges themselves when they reached the South Pole, exhausted, on 17th January 1912 and found the Norwegian flag already flying there.
